## Daily Itinerary

### Day 1 - Friday London/Stratford-upon-Avon/York

Depart from London on coach 9am. Stop in Stratford-upon-Avon to visit Shakespeare's birthplace and explore the house where he was born and grew up. Lunch at a local cafe followed by a short walk to Shakespeare's New Place, his family home in retirement (which no longer stands but in its place is a beautiful landscaped garden). Return to coach for remaining journey to York. Check into hotel in York city centre. In the evening we have a 3-course dinner at a restaurant overlooking the River Ouse.

### Day 2 - Saturday York

Breakfast in the hotel. We will meet our guide for the day before embarking on a walking tour of York. Once in the town centre we explore the beautiful Museum Gardens and enjoy a guided tour of York Minster, the iconic gothic-style medieval cathedral at the very heart of the city. Lunch will be taken at a local café before visiting York's famously characterful street known as the Shambles. Its medieval-design buildings are home to a myriad of little shops with their quaint, timber-framed structures hanging over the street as you stroll on by. We will also be exploring the old Snickelways of York where you will come across many hidden gems of the city including a chance to watch fudge being made from scratch. Afterwards we will participate in an excellent (and undoubtedly delicious) guided tour of York's Chocolate Story. There will be free time available afterwards, where you may wish to enjoy a luxurious hot chocolate from the York's Chocolate Story café or do a bit of local shopping before heading back to the hotel. In the evening we have a 3-course evening dinner at a restaurant.

### Day 3 - Sunday York/London

After our morning breakfast in the hotel, we will be going on a sightseeing cruise along the River Ouse before making the short trip over to the famous Betty's Tea Rooms for lunch. Following that there is an optional trip to York Dungeon where you can experience a 75-minute journey through centuries of Dark Age Britain: the monk of Eofowic Minster awaits you, ready to guide innocent Saxons from certain Viking wrath! After the day's excitement we return to our coach for the journey back to London, arriving early evening.
