Day 1, Saturday 13th November

UK/Nazareth

Depart London Gatwick to Aqaba (Jordan). Upon arrival coach transfer to our hotel in Petra where we will stay for two nights. Evening dinner at the hotel.

Day 2, Sunday 14th November

Petra – 'one of the new 7 wonders of the world'

After breakfast walk to the Visitors Centre and collect tickets to enter Petra. We will witness the magnificent spectacle of temples, tombs and monuments – a truly incredible sight. UNESCO has listed the Ancient city of Petra as one of the 7 New Wonders of the World. Comfortable shoes are important as the surface is little rough, rocky and dusty. Free for the rest of the afternoon to explore the Red City at your leisure. It might be possible to walk to St Georges Monastery (only abled pilgrims). This will take 2 hours of climbing. Evening dinner at the hotel.

Day 3, Monday 15th November

Moses Spring/Madaba/ Mt Nebo/Nazareth

After breakfast, checkout of hotel. We first visit Moses Spring. Continue drive towards Madaba to visit St George's church to view the original surviving 6th century Byzantine mosaic map showing Jerusalem and other holy sites located in the Greek Orthodox Church of St. George. Proceed to Mt Nebo where Moses saw the promised land. Enjoy the panoramic view. Continue our journey into Israel crossing the border. Check-in to our hotel in Nazareth. Evening dinner at the hotel.

Day 4, Tuesday 16th November

Nazareth/Tiberias/River Jordan

After breakfast, depart hotel for sailing on the Sea of Galilee from Tiberias in an ancient reproduction boat. After, we visit Capernaum – the town of Jesus. Move on to visit the Mt of the Beatitudes – where the sermon of the Mount took place; St Peter's Primacy where Christ appeared to the Apostles after His Resurrection; Tabgha for the Multiplication Shrine of the Loaves and Fishes (the feeding of the 5,000). We have our service here. Finally, we travel to the River Jordan 'Yardinete' for renewal of Baptismal Vows. Note: if you require total immersion for the renewal of Baptismal Vows, a white gown must be hired for \$15 at the site (you pay upon arrival). Return to our hotel and evening dinner here.

Day 5, Wednesday 17th November

Nazareth/Cana/Mt Tabor/Bethlehem

After breakfast, check-out of the hotel and visit the Basilica of the Annunciation viewing the Grotto where the Annunciation took place. Also visit the church of St Joseph's Workshop and the Synagogue of Jesus and Mary's Well. Leave Nazareth and proceed to Cana (Jesus performed his miracle turning water to wine), visiting Church of the Wedding - renewal of Marriage Vows here for married couples! One can purchase Cana wine to take home with you if desired and a certificate can also be purchased (\$5 each). Drive to the foot of Mt Tabor and taxis up to the church of Transfiguration. Continue journey to Bethlehem. Check-in to hotel and dinner here.

Day 6, Thursday 18th November

Bethlehem/Shepherd's Field

After breakfast walk to Manger Square (the oldest complete church in the Christian world). We visit The Grotto inside the Nativity Church where Jesus was born, followed by a tour, viewing the Wall mosaic from 12th century and the St Jerome's tomb and

the Chapel of the Holy Innocents. We have lunch and then proceed to Shepherd's field, visit the Grottos there and the Chapel above, where the angels first sang the 'Gloria in Excelsis Deo' on the night of the first Christmas. We will have our service here. We will have a chance to do some shopping before we return to our hotel for dinner and overnight.

Day 7, Friday 19th November

Jerusalem – Old City/Mt Zion

Early departure to Jerusalem and to the Old City (St Stephen's Gate) and walks to St Anne's church where Mary the mother of God was born. We then proceed the Garden Tomb where we have our service. Lunch in Jerusalem. Afterwards walk to the beautiful Shrine of St Peter's in Gallicantu - a truly incredible Shrine; the church that Jesus was imprisoned the night before his crucifixion. Return to our hotel and evening dinner here.

Day 8, Saturday 20th November

Day of leisure in Bethlehem

Optional visit to Old city of Jerusalem. You will be dropped off in the morning and picked up in the afternoon from the same place. The cost for this will be £20 per person. This is not a guided visit You will be on your own. Make sure that you have someone with you just in case you get lost. Evening dinner at the hotel.

Day 9, Sunday 21th November

Jerusalem / Mount of Olives / Bethany / Dead

After breakfast coach to Jerusalem to the summit of Mt of Olives and visit Pater Noster where Our Lord taught His Prayer - Our Father; walk further down to the church of Dominus Fleuit where Jesus wept when He foresaw the Destruction of the City of Jerusalem. We celebrate Eucharist here. On the way down enjoy the panoramic view overlooking the old city with a clear view of the Golden Dome of the Rock. Arriving at the basilica of All Nations, pass the Gethsemane Garden and view the oldest olive tree from the time of Jesus. We move on to the Basilica of the Agony, where Jesus spent his last night before his arrest. We spend some time here to pray and reflect, followed by lunch. Travel to Bethany to visit St Lazarus' Church (the home of Lazarus, Martha and Mary). We have lunch in Jericho then proceed to the Dead Sea to experience floating in the sea. Return to our hotel for dinner.

Day 10, Monday 22nd November

Beersheba/ Latrun Monastery

After breakfast coach travel to Beersheba, via Sha'ar Hagai, Latrun Trappist monastery (they produce their own olive oil, grape juice and wine available to purchase). Proceed to Beit Shemesh and visit Abraham's Well (subject for the road being safe to cross and open). Return to our hotel and dinner and overnight here.

Day 11, Tuesday 23rd November

Bethlehem/Jaffa/Tel Aviv/UK

We say goodbye to Bethlehem and head to Benedictine Abbey of Abu Gosh – a traditional site of the Biblical Emmaus with two amazing ancient monasteries. Proceed to Jaffa – the ancient port of the Holy Land. St Peter raised Tabitha one of Jesus' disciples from the dead. We visit the church. Proceed to the airport for our flight back to London Luton.
