DAILY ITINERARY



Day 1, Monday 22nd November **UK/Jerusalem**

We depart from London Luton airport with on a direct flight to Tel Aviv. Upon arrival at Tel Aviv airport, your guide and coach will be waiting to transfer you to your hotel in Jerusalem. Evening dinner at the hotel.

Day 2, Tuesday 23rd November **Mount of Olives/Mount Zion/Bethlehem/Shepherd's Field**

After breakfast, we start our day on the Mount of Olives. Here we will visit the Chapel of the Ascension, Pater Noster, where we see the Prayer, Our Father, in many languages. We descend and arrive at Dominus Flevit church - where Jesus wept over Jerusalem. On the way down enjoy the panoramic view overlooking the old city with a clear view of the Golden Dome of the Rock. Arriving at the basilica of All Nations, pass Gethsemane Garden and view the oldest olive tree from the time of Jesus. We move on to the Basilica of the Agony, where Jesus spent his last night before his arrest. We will take lunch and

afterwards proceed to Mount Zion where we visit the beautiful church of St Peter in Gallicantu on the eastern slopes. This church commemorates the traditional site of Peter's denial of Christ. Here we visit the ancient cave where it is believed Jesus was kept the night before his crucifixion. We then visit the Upper room where Christ ate a last meal with his disciples. Drive to Bethlehem where we visit Shepherd's Field and the Church of the Nativity. There will also be a chance to purchase souvenirs in one of the shops owned by Christians in Bethlehem. Return to our hotel and evening dinner.

Day 3, Wednesday 24th November **Jerusalem - The Old City**

After breakfast drive to Damascus Gate where we visit the Western Wall which is part of the remaining wall around the temple that was destroyed in AD70. This is the holiest site for in Judaism. Lunch, then coach to Ein Karem and visit the church of Visitation and John the Baptist church. Return to hotel and dinner here.

Day 4, Thursday 25th November **Free day at leisure**

There is an opportunity to privately visit the Holocaust Memorial Centre 'Yad Vashem' just outside Jerusalem. Dinner at the hotel.

Day 5, Friday 26th November **Masada/Qumran/Dead Sea/Tiberias**

Drive along the Judean Desert and stop in Wadi Quit desert for Mass overlooking St George's Monastery. Proceed to Masada and see the remains of the ancient fortress built over the rocky mountain by Herod the

Great in the first century BC. We ride a cable car to reach the top of the site and enjoy the spectacular view. After descending from Masada, drive along the shores of the Dead Sea to Qumran, the place where the Dead Sea Scrolls were found, where we will have lunch. Proceed to the Dead Sea for the floating experience. Continue to Tiberias and check-in to our hotel. Evening dinner and overnight here.

Day 6, Saturday 27th November **Mount Tabor/Nazareth/Cana/Tiberias**

After breakfast check-out of the hotel and travel through Judean desert to the foot of Mount Tabor (the church of Transfiguration). We take taxis to the summit. We will have wonderful views of the northern part of the Holy Land. We descend and continue to historic town of Nazareth to visit the Basilica of the Annunciation and Mary's Well (St George's church). Proceed to Cana and the church commemorating the first miracle of Christ changing water into wine. Return to our hotel. Evening dinner at the hotel.

Day 7, Sunday 28th November **Sea of Galilee/Golan Heights**

We start our day by visiting the Mount of the Beatitudes Church where the Sermon on the mount took place. We visit nearby Capernaum – the town of Jesus and the centre of his ministry. We view the remains of the ancient synagogue in which Jesus used to teach, as well as St Peter's House. To celebrate Mass, we will visit Tabgha where the multiplication of loaves and fish traditionally took place. Take a short walk to the Church of the Primacy and view the large rock of Mensa Christi where Jesus shared a meal with

his disciples. We will then take a boat ride on the Sea of Galilee in a reproduction boat of the time of Jesus. We finish our day with a visit to Ophir Observation Point on the Golan Heights for a stunning view of the entire Sea of Galilee. Return to the hotel and evening dinner here.

Day 8, Monday 29th November **Caesarea Philippi/Druze Village/Meggido/Magdala**

After breakfast, travel further north to Caesarea Philippi (Baniyas) and walk through the beautiful nature reserve. Afterwards proceed to Druze village and lunch here if possible. Continue to Megiddo – the Biblical archaeological site and visit here. Proceed to visit Mt Carmel – Carmelite Monastery where we visit the church and view the famous Elijah's cave. We celebrate Mass here. Return to our hotel and evening dinner here.

Day 9, Tuesday 30th November **Airport/Home**

Very early departure to the airport for our flight back to London Luton.
