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## DAILY ITINERARY

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surrounding area. We will have lunch and afterwards we go to the Apparition Hill/Blue Cross where our guide will explain all the information you long to hear on Our Blessed Mother's Apparition. Continue to visit the community of Cenacolo. This was founded by Sister Elvera Petrozzi in 1991 to support young people recovering from addictions and to teach them the simple way of life, with faith in Jesus, and to straighten their paths in life. *Taxi to Cenacolo not included, approximately £1 each way (4 people sharing).* Dinner at the hotel.

### Day 3, Thursday 4<sup>th</sup> June Medjugorje

After breakfast, we meet with our guide and walking from the back of St James church we climb Mount Krizevac (Cross Mountain) a kilometre away from the church, 520 metres above sea level. We have Stations of the Cross on the way to the mountain. Please note that to go up the mountain you must be reasonably fit and be very careful as the mountain has rough rocks and stones to tackle. The Gigantic Cross you see up here was erected by local people in 1933 to commemorate the 1900th anniversary of our Jesus' Crucifixion. Enjoy the view at the summit and relax before the descent. Evening dinner at the hotel.

### Day 4, Friday 5<sup>th</sup> June Medjugorje

There are many activities in and around the Sanctuary. Confessions are conducted throughout the day in many

languages. You can revisit the Risen Christ and the Apparition Hill/Blue Cross where you can pray the Rosary and say the stations of the Cross – this is immensely popular. Also, not to be missed is the Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament in the evening at the open Altar. Evening dinner at the hotel.



### Day 5, Saturday 6<sup>th</sup> June Surmanci//Mostar/Kravice

Today we explore outside Medjugorje and visit the Old City of **Mostar**, a Medieval City. The highlight is the famous Old Bridge of Mostar built in the 17th century and sadly destroyed during the Bosnia and Herzegovina war between 1992 and 1995. It is now being restored to its former glory. We celebrate Mass here. We then move on to visit the beautiful **Waterfalls of Kravice**, the biggest waterfalls in Bosnia Herzegovina - they span 120m and fall 25m, a truly spectacular unspoilt natural attraction. We stay here for just an hour before returning to Medjugorje.

### Day 6, Sunday 7<sup>th</sup> June Free time in Medjugorje

Visiting places of interest. Dinner at the hotel.

### Day 7, Monday 8<sup>th</sup> June Medjugorje/Surmanci

After breakfast, we leave Medjugorje and drive to the village of Surmanci where we celebrate Mass in the Church of the Merciful Jesus. In the church there is a miraculous icon of Jesus of Mercy. This icon was in the Sanctuary of Divine Mercy in Trento where Ugo Festa was miraculously healed when he prayed before it. It also has a small relic of St Faustina. We return to Medjugorje and have lunch here. Free for the remainder of the day.

### Day 8, Tuesday 9<sup>th</sup> June Medjugorje/UK

After breakfast, we leave for Split for our flight home. Depending on the flight time, we may be able to celebrate Mass either at Vepric Shrine or in the Cathedral of Saints Domnius.

### Day 1, Tuesday 2<sup>nd</sup> June UK/Medjugorje

We fly from London to Split or Dubrovnik. Upon arrival your guide and driver will be waiting to take you to your hotel in Medjugorje. The journey takes approximately 2 ½ hours, so sit back and relax and enjoy the beautiful panoramic view of the countryside and the Adriatic Sea. If times permits, we celebrate Mass in Vepric Holy Shrine – a small Shrine dedicated to Our Lady of Lourdes. Continue our journey to Medjugorje and then dinner at the hotel.

### Day 2, Wednesday 3<sup>rd</sup> June Medjugorje

After breakfast, we meet with our guide and walk to St James Church where we will have our concelebrated Mass. Afterwards we will have a guided walking tour of the Sanctuary and the
