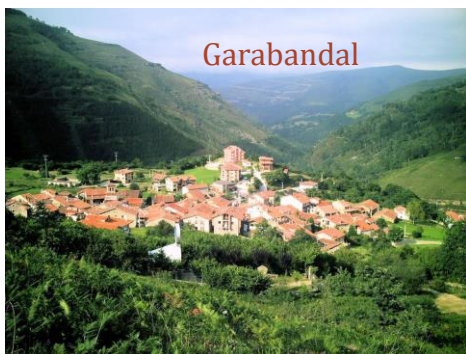

DAILY ITINERARY



Day 1, Thursday 13th June UK/Santander/Garabandal

Depart London Stansted for Santander airport. Upon arrival transfer to our hotel in Garabandal. Depending on the time of arrival we should be able to celebrate Mass here and walk up to the hill to visit the Pines where Our Lady appeared to the children. Dinner at the hotel.

Day 2, Friday 14th June Garabandal

After breakfast, we celebrate Mass in the church in Garabandal followed by a video presenting details of how the Apparitions started. We tour the village followed by Stations of the Cross arriving in the Pines (Apparition Hill) where we spend time meditating and praying. We descend to the village and do some shopping.

Day 3, Saturday 15th June Garabandal/Santo Toribio/Fatima

After breakfast, we leave Garabandal and travel over the scenic Cantabrian mountains to Santo Toribio Monastery where we celebrate Mass and venerate the relic of the true Cross. (Santo Toribio holds the largest preserved relic of the true Cross) which is kept behind the altar. Continue our journey to Fatima (journey time – seven and a half hours). Lunch en route. We aim to arrive in time for evening dinner.

Day 4, Sunday 16th June Fatima

After breakfast, walk to the Sanctuary to celebrate Mass in St Joseph's chapel (subject to availability). We have a guided tour of the Sanctuary visiting the Chapel of Apparition, the Rosary Basilica where the tomb of the seers is kept, the basilica of the Most Holy Trinity and the chapel of the Blessed Sacrament. Lunch at a local restaurant and afterwards we have a video presentation at the theatre detailing how the Apparitions began. At 9pm we participate in the Rosary at the Chapel of Apparition followed by the candlelight procession around the Sanctuary.

Day 5, Monday 17th June Fatima

After breakfast we follow the way of the Cross along Via Sacre to Valinhos. According to tradition this is the place where the first and the third apparitions of the Angel to the

seers (Francisco, Jacinta and Lucia) took place. While reciting the Rosary between the 8th and the 9th Stations, we stop to view the place where the fourth Apparition of Our Lady occurred in August 1917. Continue on to the village of Ajustrel and visit the homes where the children lived with their families. We stop at the Old Parish church to say the Rosary and return to the hotel for evening dinner. We will then participate in the International Rosary at the Chapel of Apparition followed by a Candlelight procession.

Day 6, Tuesday 18th June Fatima – Free day at leisure

After breakfast, we will attend a concelebrated Mass at the Chapel of Apparition and we say the Rosary here. We spend the rest of today at leisure in the Sanctuary visiting places of interest. In the evening, we will join the Rosary at the Chapel of Apparition followed by a Candlelight procession. Return to our hotel.

Day 7, Wednesday 19th June Fatima/Lisbon/UK

After breakfast, we leave the hotel early for Lisbon and head for St Anthony's church (*the birthplace of St Anthony - The Patron of Lost Objects*). We celebrate Mass here followed by a tour of the church. If there is enough time we will have a panoramic tour of the city and visit the Monastery of St Jeronimo before proceeding to Lisbon airport for our flight back to London Stansted.



BRIEF HISTORY OF OUR LADY OF GARABANDAL

The small, remote village of San Sebastian de Garabandal even today has only 300 inhabitants, a couple of small hotels, coffee shops, souvenir shops and 17th century church. the Blessed Virgin Mary appeared to 4 young girls, age between 11 and 12 years named Conchita González, Mari Cruz González, Jacinta González y Mari Loli Mazón from 1961 – 1965. The messages were the same as that in Fatima. The Pines where she appeared on the hill is very peaceful, tranquil and calm. Please don't expect a lot from Garabandal but embrace it with all your heart – OUR LADY VISITED THIS VILLAGE AND THAT IS WHY WE ARE HERE!
