## DAILY ITINERARY

---

### Day 1, Tuesday 12<sup>th</sup> September UK/Bethlehem

Depart London on flight to Tel Aviv Ben Gurion. Everyone meets at the airport. Please wear your AST ID tag so that your leader can easily identify that you are one of the group travelling. Upon arrival at Tel Aviv Ben Gurion airport, your guide and coach will be waiting to transfer you to your hotel in Bethlehem. Depending on the time of arrival we will have evening dinner at the hotel.

### Day 2, Wednesday 13<sup>th</sup> September Jerusalem/St Anne's Church

Early departure to Jerusalem and to the Old City and walk to St Anne's church where Our Lady was born and the Pool of Bethesda. We celebrate Mass here in honour of Our Lady's. Continue on to the church of Ecce Homo, built on the site of the Palace of Pilate. Visit Pilate's Court, the chapel of Crowing with Thorns and the condemnation chapel. Here we start the Stations of the Cross along via Dolorosa following the route Our Lord walked on the first Good Friday. We can carry a Cross here (optional). We will take turns to carry a cross here changing at every station, and finish in the Holy Sepulcher Basilica - (the holiest place on earth). Afterwards visit Mt Calvary, the Holy Tomb of Jesus, St Mary Magdalene's Shrine, visit the Grotto of the True Cross. We walk to Mt Zion to visit the

Upper Room – The Last Supper and the Tomb of King David and move on to visit the magnificent Dormition Abbey where Our Lady was assumed to heaven. Return to hotel for dinner

### Day 3, Thursday 14<sup>th</sup> September Bethlehem

Depart for Manger Square about 8 am., Mass in St Joseph's Grotto - Franciscan Church of the Nativity, visit the Grotto of the Nativity - where Jesus was born, and afterwards the Milk Grotto - and visit the Museum of the Miracles. Local bus to Shepherds' Fields, visit Grottos there, and visit Chapel above - where the angels first sang the 'Gloria in Excelsis Deo' on the night of the first Christmas. Shopping in Bethlehem. This will be the main shopping you will be allowed. Return to our hotel for dinner.

### Day 4, Friday 15<sup>th</sup> September Jerusalem/Jericho/Dead Sea

Coach to the summit of the Mt of Olives, Jerusalem; visit Ascension Dome, Pater Noster Grotto where Jesus thought His Prayer, Our Father), walk to Dominus Fleuit (where Jesus wept over Jerusalem). We celebrate Mass here and afterwards proceed to Gethsemane Garden and Basilica. Visit the Assumption Church. Coach to Ein Karem and visit the Visitation Shrine of Our Lady then on to Birthplace of St John the Baptist. Drive back to Gethsemane for Holy Hour of Eucharistic Adoration around the Rock of the Agony inside the Basilica. This is the exact place Jesus underwent His Agony. Return to hotel for dinner.

### Day 5, Saturday 16<sup>th</sup> September Jerusalem/Jericho/Dead Sea

Visit Western (Wailing) Wall which is part of the remaining wall around the temple that was destroyed in AD70. Depart for Bethany, visit St Lazarus's Church and proceed to Jericho, view Mt of Temptation and Zacchaeus's Sycamore Tree. Lunch. Proceed to the Dead Sea and experience the floating in the Sea. Return to our hotel for dinner.

### Day 6, Sunday 17<sup>th</sup> September Nazareth/Cana

We leave Bethlehem and drive along the Jordan Valley to Mt Tabor. Here we take a mini-bus in a beautifully scenic drive to the summit, where we visit the Church of Transfiguration. Proceed to Nazareth and on to the Annunciation. We visit the Grotto where the Annunciation took place and St Joseph's Grotto. We celebrate Mass here. Afterwards we tour the remaining sections of the Basilica - it is renowned as one of the finest churches in the Middle East. Continue on to visit the Synagogue of Jesus and Mary's Well. Proceed to Cana – the church of the Wedding where Our Lord Jesus performed his first miracle. Renewal of our Marriage Vows here. Check-in to our hotel and overnight here.

### Day 7, Monday 18<sup>th</sup> September Tiberias/Sea of Galilee/River Jordan

Depart hotel and sail on the Sea of Galilee. This will be one of the highlights of your pilgrimage (45 minutes ride in an ancient reproduction boat). Afterwards drive to Capernaum and tour here visiting the church of St Peter and remains of the ancient Synagogue. We also visit Mt Beatitudes where the Sermon on the Mount took place and St Peter's Primacy

where Christ appeared to the Apostles after His Resurrection. Mass here. Drive to the River Jordan 'Yardenit' for renewal of Baptismal Vows. Return to our hotel for our evening dinner.

### Day 8, Tuesday 19<sup>th</sup> September Nazareth/UK

We go up to the summit of Mt Tabor by taxis the Church of Transfiguration and tour here. We celebrate Mass in this beautiful Basilica. Lunch in a nearby restaurant then proceed to the airport for our flight back to London.
