

DAILY ITINERARY

Excellent Catholic itinerary & outstanding value for money pilgrimage.

Day 1, Tuesday 9th October

UK/Bethlehem

Depart London Luton on flight to Tel Aviv (scheduled departure at 9.40am) Please *wear your badge* so that you can be easily identified as one of the group. Upon arrival at Tel Aviv airport your guide and coach will be waiting to transfer you to your hotel in Bethlehem. Evening dinner at the hotel.

Day 2, Wednesday 10th October

Bethlehem/Shepherds' Fields

Depart for Manger Square, Mass in St Joseph's Grotto - Franciscan Church of the Nativity, visit the Grotto of the Nativity - where Jesus was born, and afterwards the Milk Grotto - and visit the Museum of the Miracles. Local bus to Shepherd's field, visit Grottos there, and visit Chapel above - where the angels first sang the 'Gloria in Excelsis Deo' on the night of the first Christmas. Shopping in Bethlehem. Return to our hotel for dinner.

Day 3, Thursday 11th October

Jerusalem – Old City

Early departure to Jerusalem and to the Old City (Lions Gate) and walk to St Anne's church, where Our Lady was born, and the Pool of Bethesda. We proceed to the church of Ecce Homo, built on the site of the Palace of Pilate and start the Stations of the Cross along via Dolorosa, following the route Our Lord walked on the first Good Friday. We

will take turns to carry a cross here changing at every station, and finish in the Holy Sepulchre Basilica - (the holiest place on earth) and we celebrate Mass in the Chapel of Apparition. Afterwards visit Mt Calvary, the Holy Tomb of Jesus and the Grotto of the True Cross. We walk to Mt Zion to visit the Upper Room and the Tomb of King David and move on to visit the magnificent Dormition Abbey where Our Lady was assumed to heaven.

Day 4, Friday 12th October

Jerusalem/Jericho/Dead Sea

After breakfast travel to Bethany, visit St Lazarus's Church and we celebrate Mass here. Proceed to Jericho, view Mt of Temptation and Zacchaeus's Sycamore Tree. Lunch in Qumran or Jericho. After lunch, proceed to the Dead Sea for the floating experience. We spend a few hours here. If time permits we go to Ein Gedi (National Park) and visit here (entrance fees not included). Return to our hotel and dinner here.

Day 5, Saturday 13th October

Mt of Olives and Ein Karem

Coach to the summit of the Mt of Olives and visit Bethphage (the starting point of Jesus' triumphal entry into Jerusalem). Visit Ascension Dome, Pater Noster Grotto, where Jesus taught His Prayer, Our Father. We walk to Dominus Flevit where Jesus wept over Jerusalem. We celebrate Mass here and afterwards proceed to Gethsemane Garden and Basilica. We

visit the Assumption Church followed by lunch. Drive to Ein Karem and the Visitation Shrine of Our Lady. Then on to the birthplace of St John the Baptist. Return to our hotel for our evening dinner.

Day 6, Sunday 14th October

Jerusalem – Old City

Early departure to Jerusalem to visit the tower of David (optional) to see the most spectacular view of the city. Visit the "Wailing" Western Wall - the holiest site in Judaism because it is part of the remaining wall around the temple that was destroyed in 70 AD. Afterwards visit the Golden Dome of the Rock. Proceed to St Peter's in Gallicantu - a truly incredible Shrine - and visit the dungeon where Jesus was imprisoned after His mock trial on Maundy Thursday night. We celebrate Mass here. Dinner at the hotel.

Day 7, Monday 15th October

Nazareth/Cana/Jacob's Well

After breakfast, we leave Bethlehem and travel to Nablus and visit Jacob's Well, where Jesus asked a Samaritan woman for a drink and offered her "living water". The well lies in the crypt of a modern Greek Orthodox church at Nablus. Continue to Nazareth to visit the magnificent Annunciation Basilica that dominates the skyline there. We visit the Grotto where the Annunciation took place and St Joseph's Grotto. We celebrate Mass here. We also visit the Synagogue of Jesus and Mary's Well. After lunch we proceed to Cana for renewal of Marriage Vows. Check-in to

our hotel in Nazareth and dinner here.

Day 8, Tuesday 16th October

Nazareth/Tiberias

Drive to Tiberias and River Jordan 'Yardinit' for the renewal of Baptismal Vows and spend some time here. Proceed to Mt of Beatitudes where the Sermon on the Mount took place, then to St Peter's Primacy where Christ appeared to the Apostles after His Resurrection. We celebrate Mass here before moving on to the church of the Feeding of the 5,000. We will have lunch in St. Peter's restaurant. Then we take a boat on the Sea of Galilee (one of the highlights of your pilgrimage). On to Capernaum - the town of Jesus - where we visit the Church of St Peter and the remains of the ancient synagogue. Return to hotel for our evening dinner.

Day 9, Wednesday 17th October

Mt Tabor/ Mt Carmel/Nain/UK

After breakfast drive to Nain to visit the house of the woman whose dead son Jesus brought back to life then to Mt Tabor, the church of Transfiguration, Taxis up the mountain and Mass here. Proceed to Haifa – Mt Carmel and visit the Basilica of Our Lady Star of the Sea – Carmelite Headquarters and we visit the Cave of Prophet Elijah. Proceed to the airport for our flight back to London Heathrow.
