Daily itinerary

Excellent itinerary and value for money pilgrimage

Day 1, Tuesday 13th Nov. UK/Bethlehem: Depart London Luton (day time flight). Upon arrival coach transfer to our hotel in Bethlehem. Evening dinner in hotel (depending on time of arrival).

Day 2, Wednesday 14th Nov. Bethlehem/Shepherd's Field: Depart for Manger Square about 8.30 am, immediately we visit the Grotto of the Nativity - where Jesus was born (to avoid long queue and huge crowds) and followed by a Mass in St Joseph's Grotto. Afterwards we tour the Basilica of the Nativity visiting St Catherine's church, St Joseph's Grotto and St Jerome. Afterwards we walk to and visit the Milk Grotto - and visit the Museum of the Miracles. We will have lunch at the Square. Local bus to Shepherd's field, visit Grottos there and Chapel above - where the angels first sang the 'Gloria in excelsis Deo' on the night of the first Christmas. We sing Carols here. Shopping in Bethlehem before we return to our hotel.

Day 4, Thursday 15th Nov. Jerusalem/Ein Karem:). Coach to Jerusalem and visit St Peter's in Gallicantu - a truly incredible Shrine and see the dungeon where Jesus was imprisoned after His mock trial on Maundy Thursday night. Walk to Mt Zion and visit the Upper room and King David's Tomb then onto Dormition Abbey where our Lady assumed to heaven. Lunch. Proceed to Ein Karem to see the Visitation Shrine, and the Birthplace of St John the Baptist and we celebrate Mass here. Return to our hotel for dinner.

Day 4, Friday 16th Nov. Jerusalem (Old City: Coach to Jerusalem, arrive in Damascus Gate Visit the "Wailing" Western Wall - the holiest site in Judaism because it is part of the remaining wall around the temple that was destroyed in 70 AD. Proceed to St Anne's church the birthplace of our Lady and visit here and the Pool of Bethesda. Proceed to Basilica of Ecce Homo, visit Pilate's Court, Crowning with Thorns and the Condemnation Chapels followed by a Stations of the Cross along the Via Dolorosa (a Cross is available to carry if desired) and ends in the Holy Sepulchre Basilica (the holiest place on earth). We celebrate Mass in the Chapel of Apparition. We continue our guided tour here and visit Mt Calvary, the Holy Tomb of the Resurrection, Blessed Sacrament Chapel and the True Cross. We spend some time here for private prayers and devotion. Return back to our hotel. Evening dinner and overnight here.

Day 5, Saturday 17th Nov. Jerusalem (Mt of Olives): Coach to the summit of the Mt of Olives, Jerusalem; visit Ascension Dome, Pater Noster Grotto, walk to Dominus Fleuit (where Jesus wept over Jerusalem), Mass here. Afterwards we proceed to Gethsemane Garden and Basilica and the Grotto. We also visit the Assumption Church. Lunch and then free for shopping. Return to the church of All Nations (Mt of Olives) for our Holy Hour inside the Basilica with Eucharistic Adoration around the Rock of the Agony. This is the exact place Jesus underwent His Agony.

Day 6, Sunday 18th Nov. Bethlehem/Jericho/Bethany/Dead Sea: Depart for Jericho and view the Mt of Temptation from across the valley. **Note:** for those who are interested in going up the mountain the cost of the cable car is extra. Proceed to the

Dead Sea for the floating experience then on to Bethany and visit St Lazarus' Shrine. We celebrate Mass here. Return to our hotel for dinner.

Day 7, Monday 19th Nov. Nazareth/Cana: We leave Bethlehem and drive along the Jordan Valley to Nazareth and here we visit the imposing Basilica of the Annunciation, viewing the Grotto where the Annunciation took place, the Upper Basilica' St Joseph's Workshop, Synagogue of Jesus and Mary's Well. We now drive to Cana, visiting the Church of the Wedding - renewal of Marriage Vows here! (one can if desired, buy Cana Wine in a local shop). Check-in to our hotel in Nazareth. Evening dinner at our hotel.

Day 8, Tuesday 20th Nov. Tiberias (Jordan River/Sea of Galilee/Capernaum/St Peter's Primacy/Mt Beatitudes): Leave the hotel and proceed to the River Jordan for renewal of our Baptismal Vows, Continue on to Tiberias and we will go sailing on the Sea of Galilee in an ancient re-production boat. Afterwards drive to Capernaum (the town of Jesus) and tour here viewing St Peter's Church and the remains of the ancient Synagogue in which Jesus used to teach and view other ancient remains here. We also visit the Mt of Beatitudes (the Sermon on the Mount took place) and admire the incredible view of the Sea of Galilee. Proceed to St Peter's Primacy, where Christ appeared to the Apostles after His resurrection, we celebrate Mass here. Drive to the Multiplication Shrine, where Jesus multiplied a few fish and 5 loaves to feed 5,000. Return to hotel and dinner here.

Day 9, Wednesday 21st Nov. Mt Tabor/Mt Carmel/Nazareth: We drive to the summit of Mt Tabor and take taxis up the mountain (included). We tour the Basilica of the Transfiguration and celebrate Mass here. Drive to Acre and visit here. Proceed to Mt Carmel (Haifa), Basilica of Our Lady Star of the Sea - Carmelite Headquarters. We now return to our hotel in Nazareth for evening dinner and overnight.

Day 10, Thursday 22nd Nov. Nazareth/UK: Drive to Tel Aviv - Jaffa Mass in St Peter's church and we have lunch here. If time permits, we walk along the promenade of the long beautiful beach of Jaffa. Proceed to the airport for our flight back to London.
