

## DAILY ITINERARY

### **Day 1, Tuesday, 5<sup>th</sup> March:**

#### **UK/Bethlehem:**

Depart from London Luton airport for our direct flight to Tel Aviv. Please **wear your badge** so that your leader can easily identify that you are one of the group travelling. Upon arrival at Tel Aviv airport, your guide and coach will be waiting to transfer you to your hotel in Bethlehem. Dinner at the hotel depending on the time of arrival.

### **Day 2, Wednesday 6<sup>th</sup> March:**

#### **Bethlehem/Shepherds Fields:**

Depart for Manger Square about, Mass in St Joseph's Grotto - Franciscan Church of the Nativity, visit the Grotto of the Nativity - where Jesus was born, and afterwards the Milk Grotto - and visit the Museum of the Miracles. Local bus to Shepherds' Fields, visit Grottos there, and visit Chapel above - where the angels first sang the 'Gloria in Excelsis Deo' on the night of the first Christmas. Shopping in Bethlehem. This will be the main shopping you will be

allowed. Return to our hotel for dinner.

### **Day 3, Thursday 7<sup>th</sup> March:**

#### **Jerusalem:**

Early departure for Jerusalem to the Old City. Visit Western Wall, then walk to the church of Ecce Homo, built on the site of the Palace of Pilate where we start our Stations of the Cross along via Dolorosa, following the route Our Lord walked on the first Good Friday and ending in the Holy Sepulcher Basilica - the holiest place on earth. We celebrate Mass in one of the chapels here (if possible). Afterwards we visit the Holy Tomb of Jesus, Mt Calvary, and the Grotto of the True Cross. Lunch break then continue to visit the Chapel of the Upper Room, the magnificent Dormition Abbey where Our Lady was assumed to heaven, St Peter's in Gallicantu - a truly incredible Shrine, and we visit the dungeon where Jesus was imprisoned after His mock trial on Maundy Thursday night. Return to our hotel.

### **Day 4, Friday 8<sup>th</sup> March:**

#### **Jerusalem/Jericho/Dead Sea**

Coach to the Summit of Mt of Olives, Jerusalem; visit Ascension Dome, Pater Noster Grotto, walk to Dominus Fleuit (where Jesus wept over Jerusalem), Mass here and afterwards proceed to Gethsemane Garden and Basilica (the beautiful Church of all Nations). Drive to Jericho, view Mt of Temptation and Zacchaeus's Sycamore Tree followed by lunch in Qumran. Then on to the Dead Sea for the swimming/floating experience. Return to our hotel and dinner.

### **Day 5, Saturday 9<sup>th</sup> March:**

#### **Free day at your leisure:**

Free day in Bethlehem. Mass will be

arranged in the Carmel of Bethlehem, a short walk from the hotel (where King David lived as a boy). View here the magnificent chapel of St Joseph (designed by Christ, and shown in a vision to St Mary of Jesus Crucified). There will be an optional trip to the OLD CITY of Jerusalem. This will be a non-guided trip. You will be dropped off in Jaffa Gate and be picked up here at 5pm approximately. Cost US\$10 per person. Dinner at the hotel.

### **Day 6, Sunday, 10<sup>th</sup> March:**

#### **Nazareth/Cana/Mt Tabor:**

Leave the hotel early and travel to Mt Tabor. Here we take a mini-bus in a beautifully scenic drive to the summit, where we visit the Church of Transfiguration. Drive to Cana visiting the Church of the Wedding and enter Nazareth, where we check into our hotel for one night. Free time for lunch in Nazareth. We meet later at the hotel where we visit the imposing Basilica of the Annunciation, viewing the Grotto where the Annunciation took place. We celebrate Mass in the magnificent Upper Basilica and afterwards we tour the remaining sections of the Basilica - it is renowned as one of the finest churches in the Middle East. Continue to visit St Joseph's Workshop and the Synagogue of Jesus. Return to the hotel for dinner.

### **Day 7, Monday 11<sup>th</sup> March:**

#### **Tiberias/Sea of Galilee:**

After breakfast, leave the hotel for Tiberias. We sail on the Sea of Galilee. This will be one of the highlights of your pilgrimage (45 minutes ride in an ancient reproduction boat). Afterwards drive to Capernaum and tour here visiting the church of St Peter and remains of the ancient Synagogue. We also

visit Mt Beatitudes where the Sermon on the Mount took place and St Peter's Primacy where Christ appeared to the Apostles after His Resurrection. We celebrate Mass here. Drive to the Church of the Feeding of the 5,000 and on to the River Jordan 'Yardenit' for renewal of Baptismal Vows. Drive back to our hotel in Bethlehem.

### **Day 8, Tuesday 12<sup>th</sup> March:**

#### **Ein Karem/UK:**

Depart for Ein Karem and the Visitation Shrine of Our Lady to St Elizabeth. We celebrate Mass here. Walk further along the road to visit St John the Baptist's birthplace. Depending on the time of our flight it may be possible to stop in Jaffa and visit St Peter's church. Continue our journey to the airport for our flight back to the UK.
