

DAILY ITINERARY



The church of All Nations

Day 1, Saturday 13th Friday April UK/Nazareth

Depart London Heathrow with El Al from London Heathrow on our direct flight to Tel Aviv. (Night flight. Arrive early morning.

Day 2, Sunday 14th April Palm Sunday – Jerusalem

Arrive in Tel Aviv at 5:30 and transfer to our hotel in Bethlehem. Rest in the morning and in the afternoon coach to Jerusalem to the summit of the Mt of Olives (Bethphage) to join the Palm Sunday Procession led by the Latin Patriarch of Jerusalem to St Anne's. Free time in Jerusalem. Souvenir shopping before returning to our hotel for dinner. Return to our hotel for our evening dinner.

Day 3, Monday 15th April Jericho/Mt Tabor/Nazareth/Cana

We leave Bethlehem and drive along the Jordan Valley to Jericho to view the Mt of Temptation. Proceed to Mt Tabor - the church of Transfiguration – taxis up the mountain. Moving on, drive to Nazareth and on to the magnificent Basilica of Annunciation that dominates

the skyline of Nazareth. We visit the Grotto where the Annunciation took place and St Joseph's Grotto. Walk across the road to visit the Synagogue of Jesus. Continue to Cana - the church of the wedding where Jesus performed his first miracle. Check-in to our hotel in Nazareth and dinner here.

Day 4, Tuesday 16th April Tiberias/Sea of Galilee/Jacobs Well

Drive to Tiberias and River Jordan 'Yardinit' for the renewal of Baptismal Vows. Proceed to Mt of Beatitudes where the Sermon on the Mount took place, then to St Peter's Primacy where Christ appeared to the Apostles after His Resurrection and then to the church of the Feeding of the 5,000. We will have lunch here and afterwards a boat sail on the Sea of Galilee (one of the highlights of your pilgrimage). Then on to Capernaum - the town of Jesus - where we visit the Church of St Peter and the remains of the ancient synagogue here. Drive back towards Bethlehem and stop in Nablus and visit Jacob's Well, where Jesus asked a Samaritan woman for a drink and offered her "living water". The well lies in the crypt of a modern Greek Orthodox church at Nablus. Return to hotel for our evening dinner.

Day 5, Wednesday 17th April Jerusalem – Old City

Early coach to Jerusalem to the Old City. We make a short walk to the Holy Sepulchre Basilica, *visiting* Mt Calvary and the Holy Tomb of the Resurrection. After a lunch break we move on to visit the Chapel of the Upper Room, King

David's Tomb and the magnificent Dormition Abbey. We walk down to St Peter's in Gallicantu - *a truly incredible Shrine*, and visit the dungeon where Jesus was imprisoned after His mock trial on Maundy Thursday night. Check-in to our hotel in Bethlehem and evening dinner here.

Day 6, Thursday 18th April Walking tour of Bethlehem/Ein Karem

After breakfast, we walk from our hotel to Manger Square and the Basilica of the Nativity to visit the grotto where Jesus was born. Afterwards we walk to the Milk Grotto to visit the 'Museum of the Miracles'. Following this we travel by coach to Ein Karem to visit the Visitation Shrine of Mary to her cousin of St Elizabeth. Walk down to visit the Church of St John the Baptist to view the grotto where he was born. We return to Bethlehem where we will visit the Shepherds' Field and grottos there and tour the chapel above where the angels first sang 'Gloria in Excelsis Deo' on the night of the first Christmas.

Day 7, Friday 19th April Good Friday - Jerusalem

Very early departure to Jerusalem and proceed to the Garden Tomb for our meditative service. This depends on the time of our arrival in Jerusalem. Afterwards we walk to the beautiful church of St Anne's where Mary was born. Here we also visit the Pool of Bethesda. We then walk further down to the Basilica of Ecce Homo to Pilate's Court where Jesus was tried. This is followed by the Way of the Cross along

the Via Dolorosa, finishing inside the Holy Sepulchre. A cross can be carried along the stations, taken in turns/ changing at every station. Here in the Holy Sepulchre we visit the Holy Tomb of Resurrection and Mt Calvary. Return to our hotel and evening dinner here.

Day 8, Saturday 20th April Free day at leisure in Bethlehem Evening dinner at the hotel.

Day 9, Sunday Monday 22nd April Jerusalem – HE HAS RISEN

Early departure to Jerusalem and proceed to the Garden Tomb to attend Sunrise Resurrection Services. Please note that if the services are a little bit longer than expected, our visits to other Sites could possibly be reduced. Afterwards we walk down to visit the "Wailing" Western Wall - the holiest site in Judaism - part of the remaining wall around the temple that was destroyed in 70 AD. Continuing, we visit the Golden Dome of the Rock - this is the third Holiest place in Islam. Return to our hotel for dinner and overnight.

Day 10, Monday 22nd April Jaffa/Airport

We say farewell to Bethlehem and head towards Tel Aviv, we stop in Jaffa visit St Peter's church and walk along the promenade of Jaffa's beautiful sandy beach. If time permits, we could have lunch here. Proceed to the airport for our flight back to London Heathrow.
