DAILY ITINERARY



Day 1, Wednesday 29th May

UK/Bethlehem

Depart London Stanstead with easyJet Airline direct to Tel Aviv Ben-Gurion Airport. Upon arrival coach transfer to our hotel in Bethlehem. Evening dinner in our hotel and overnight. Sandwiches, tea/coffee will be served if we arrive after 10pm.

Day 2, Thursday 30th May

Bethlehem/Shepherds' Fields

Depart for Manger Square about 8.30 am, immediately we visit the Grotto of the Nativity - where Jesus was born (to avoid long queue and huge crowds) and follow with a Mass in St Joseph's Grotto. Afterwards we tour the Basilica of the Nativity, visiting St Catherine's church, St Joseph's Grotto and St Jerome. Afterwards we walk to the Milk Grotto - and visit the Museum of the Miracles. We will have lunch at the Square. Local bus to Shepherd's field, visit Grottos there and Chapel above - where the angels first sang the 'Gloria in excelsis Deo' on the night of the first Christmas. We sing Carols here. Proceed to Ein Karem and

visit the Visitation Shrine and the Birthplace of St John the Baptist. Return to our hotel for our evening dinner.

Day 3, Friday 31st May

Jerusalem (Old City)

Coach to Jerusalem, arrive in St Stephens Gate and proceed to St Anne's church, the birthplace of our Lady, and the Pool of Bethesda. Proceed to Basilica of Ecce Homo, visit Pilate's Court, Crowning with Thorns and the Condemnation Chapels, followed by Stations of the Cross along the Via Dolorosa (a Cross is available to carry if desired) and ending in the Holy Sepulchre Basilica (the holiest place on earth). We celebrate Mass in the Chapel of Apparition. We continue our guided tour here and visit Mt Calvary, the Holy Tomb of the Resurrection, St Mary Magdalene's Shrine, Blessed Sacrament Chapel and the True Cross. We walk to St Peter's in Gallicantu - a truly incredible Shrine - and see the dungeon where Jesus was imprisoned after His mock trial on Maundy Thursday night. Walk to Mt Zion and visit the Upper room and King David's Tomb then on to Dormition Abbey where our Lady was assumed to heaven. Dinner at the hotel.

Day 4, Saturday 1st June

Mt of Olives/Dead Sea

Coach to the summit of the Mt of Olives, Jerusalem; visit the Ascension Dome then Pater Noster Grotto where Jesus taught his disciples the Prayer (Our Father), then walk to Dominus Flevit where Jesus wept over Jerusalem. We celebrate Mass here. Afterwards we proceed to Gethsemane Garden and the Church of All Nations. Proceed to the Dead Sea and experience the floating in the sea. Return to our hotel for dinner.

Day 5, Sunday 2nd June

Free day at leisure.

Mass will be arranged either in the Nativity church or at Carmel of Bethlehem, a short walk (where King David lived as a boy). View here the magnificent chapel of St Joseph (designed by Christ and shown in a vision to the Founded by St. Mary of Jesus Crucified). Evening dinner at the hotel.

Day 6, Monday 3rd June

Mt Tabor/Nazareth/Cana

We leave Bethlehem and drive along the Jordan Valley to Bethany and visit St Lazarus' church (the home of Mary, Martha and Lazarus) and we celebrate Mass here. Continue our journey on to the church of Transfiguration. Taxis up to the summit and we tour here. Proceed to Nazareth and on to the magnificent Annunciation Basilica that dominates the skyline of Nazareth. Here we visit the grotto where the Annunciation took place and St Joseph's Grotto. We celebrate Mass here and afterwards we walk across the road to visit the Synagogue of Jesus and Mary's Well. This is followed by lunch and we then proceed to Cana for renewal of Marriage Vows (one can if desired, purchase Cana Wine in a local shop). Check-in to our hotel in Nazareth. Evening dinner at our hotel.

Day 7, Tuesday 4th June

Tiberias (Jordan River/Sea of Galilee/Capernaum/St Peter's Primacy/Mt Beatitudes)

Leave the hotel and proceed to the River Jordan for renewal of our Baptismal Vows. Continue on to Tiberias and we will have a sail on the Sea of Galilee in an ancient re-production boat. Afterwards drive to Capernaum (the



town of Jesus) and tour here, viewing St Peter's Church and the remains of the ancient Synagogue in which Jesus used to teach. We view other ancient remains here. We also visit the Mt of Beatitudes where the Sermon on the Mount took place and admire the incredible view of the Sea of Galilee. Proceed to St Peter's Primacy, where Christ appeared to the Apostles after His resurrection and we celebrate Mass here. We then drive to the Multiplication Shrine, where Jesus multiplied a few fish and 5 loaves to feed 5,000. Return to hotel for dinner.

Day 8, Wednesday 5th June

Mt Tabor/Mt Carmel/Nazareth

We checkout of the hotel and head towards Haifa and visit Mt Carmel - the Basilica of Our Lady Star of the Sea - Carmelite Headquarters. We view the Cave of Prophet Elijah and we celebrate Mass here. Along the way we stop and view the impressive Bahá'í gardens and temple. This is a UNESCO World Heritage Site declared in 2008 in recognition of their global value as holy places of pilgrimage for the Bahá'í faith. Depending on the time of flight departure, we may stop in Jaffa (Tel Aviv) to visit St Peter's Church in Tel Aviv. Proceed to the airport for our flight back to London.
