DAILY ITINERARY



Day 1, Thursday 5th Dec. **UK/Bethlehem**

Depart Manchester airport on flight to Tel Aviv. Everyone meets at the airport. Upon arrival at Tel Aviv airport your guide and coach will be waiting to transfer you to your hotel in Bethlehem. Dinner at the hotel.

Day 2, Friday 6th Dec. **Bethlehem/Shepherds' Field/Yad Vashem**

Depart for Manger Square. We will have Mass in St Joseph's Grotto underneath St Catherine's Church. We then tour the Franciscan Church of the Nativity, the traditional birthplace of Jesus Christ. We depart Manger Square for the Milk Grotto, just a short walk away, visiting the Museum of the Miracles there. After lunch we travel by coach to the Shepherds' Field, visiting the grottos there and the Chapel where the angels first sang '*Gloria in Excelsis Deo*' on the night of the first Christmas. We may sing Christmas Carols here. We then drive to Jerusalem to visit the

Holocaust Remembrance Center. (This is not a guided visit.) Free time to explore the centre individually. We will briefly stop for some shopping in Bethlehem before returning to the hotel.

Day 3, Saturday 7th Dec. **Jerusalem (Old City and Mt Zion)**

Early departure to the Old City of Jerusalem. Proceed to the Pool of Bethesda and St Anne's Church (the birthplace of Our Lady). Continue on to visit the site of Pilate's Court, Churches of the Flagellation and the Crowning with Thorns followed by the Stations of the Cross along Via Dolorosa following the route Our Lord walked on the first Good Friday and ending in the Holy Sepulchre Basilica - the holiest place on earth for all Christians. We celebrate Mass here and afterwards visit Mt Calvary, the Holy Tomb of Resurrection, St Mary Magdalene's Shrine, and the Grotto of the True Cross. Walk to Mt Zion and visit the Upper Room (last supper), King David's Tomb and the magnificent Dormition Abbey where Our Lady was assumed to heaven. Then on to St Peter's in Gallicantu - a truly incredible Shrine and visit the dungeon where Jesus was imprisoned after His mock trial on Maundy Thursday night. Return to our hotel for dinner.

Day 3, Sunday 8th Dec. **Jerusalem/Mt of Olives**

We first visit the Western Wall which is part of the remaining wall around the temple that was destroyed in AD70.

This is the holiest place for Jews. Afterwards proceed to summit of the Mt of Olives, Jerusalem; visit Ascension Dome, Pater Noster Grotto where Jesus taught His Prayer, Our Father. We then walk to Dominus Flevit (where Jesus wept over Jerusalem). We celebrate Mass here and afterwards proceed to Gethsemane Garden and Basilica view the Rock of the Agony and we spend a few minutes here for prayer/reflection. Return to our hotel for our evening dinner. We will return to Jerusalem - Gethsemane for our Holy Hour of Eucharistic Adoration around the Rock of the Agony inside the Basilica of the church of All Nations. This is the exact place Jesus underwent His Agony. If there isn't time we will go back here after evening dinner at the hotel.

Day 5, Monday 9th Dec. **Free day at leisure**

We visit the Carmel of Bethlehem, a short walk (where King David lived as a boy). View here the magnificent chapel of St Joseph (designed by Christ and shown in a vision to the Founded by St. Mary of Jesus Crucified). We celebrate Mass here. Dinner at the hotel.

Day 7, Tuesday 10th Dec. **Bethany/Jericho/Mt Tabor/Nazareth/Cana**

Early departure to Bethany and visit St Lazarus's Church. Proceed to Jericho, view Mt of Temptation and Zacchaeus's Sycamore Tree. Lunch here. Drive to the foot of Mt Tabor, Taxis up to the summit of Mt Tabor to the Church of Transfiguration and visit

here. Proceed to Nazareth on to the Annunciation Basilica (a magnificent Basilica that dominates the skyline of Nazareth). We visit the Grotto where the Annunciation took place and St Joseph's Grotto. We celebrate Mass here. Walk across the road to visit the Synagogue of Jesus and Mary's Well. Proceed to Cana for renewal of Marriage Vows. Check-in to our hotel in Nazareth. Evening dinner here.

Day 6, Wednesday 11th Dec. **Tiberias/River Jordan/Tabgha**

After breakfast, drive to the River Jordan (Yardenit) for the renewal of Baptismal Vows, then on to Mt of Beatitudes where the Sermon on the Mount took place, St Peter's Primacy where Christ appeared to the Apostles after His Resurrection and the church of the Feeding of the 5,000. We will have lunch here and then sail on the Sea of Galilee and on to Capernaum - the town of Jesus, where we visit St Peter's Church, here we view the remains of the ancient Synagogue in which Jesus used to teach. We travel back to Bethlehem and check-in to our hotel. Dinner and overnight here.

Day 8, Thursday 12th Dec. **Ein Karem/Airport/UK**

We say farewell to Bethlehem and travel to Ein Karem to visit St John the Baptist's birthplace followed by a visit of the Visitation Shrine of Our Lady to St Elizabeth, celebrating Mass here. Travel to the airport for our flight back to Manchester airport.
