

DAILY ITINERARY



Day 1, Monday 4th May UK/Tel Aviv/Bethlehem

Depart London Luton with easyJet to Tel Aviv. Transfer to our hotel in Bethlehem. Dinner and overnight here.

Day 2, Tuesday 5th May Bethlehem/Jerusalem

After breakfast, coach to Jerusalem and we first visit the excavations at the City of David, proceed to the Davidson Centre- the Jerusalem Archaeological Park - that reveals the most amazing discoveries of Jerusalem during the Second Temple period. At the foot of the southern wall of the Temple Mount, in the area known as the Ophel, the visitor can climb up the original steps of the Hulda Gates that led to the Temple Mount. Continue our visit to the Christian Quarter; Via Dolorosa, Pool of Bethesda, visit St Anne's Crusader Church, Ecce Homo, Antonia Fortress and the Church of the Holy Sepulchre. Return to our hotel. Dinner and overnight here.

Day 3, Wednesday 6th May Masada/Qumran/Dead Sea

Travel from Bethlehem through the Judean desert and we first visit Qumran where the

Ancient Dead Sea Scrolls were found. Proceed to Masada Fortress (cable car to the top of the mountain) and we look around. We descend and proceed to the Dead Sea for the floating/swimming experience. Return to our hotel, Dinner and overnight here.

Day 4, Thursday 7th May Jerusalem /Ein Karem

Today we visit Jasons Tomb, Monastery of the Cross, the famous Chagall Windows in Ein Karem, Yad Vashem (Holocaust Museum) and finish our day in the Garden Tomb. Return to our hotel. Dinner and overnight here.

Day 5, Friday 8th May Jerusalem (Mt of Olives)/Bethlehem

We begin our tour on the Mount of Olives for a breath-taking view over the city of Jerusalem. Walk down the traditional Palm Sunday route to the Church of All Nations and the Garden of Gethsemane. Proceed to the Israel Museum and visit the Model of the ancient Jerusalem in the time of the Second Temple and the Shrine of the Book where the Dead Sea Scrolls are on display. Return to Bethlehem to visit the Church of Nativity and the cave where traditionally Jesus was born. Return to our hotel. Dinner and overnight here.

Day 6, Saturday 9th May Beersheba/Jerusalem

We leave Bethlehem and travel to Beersheba, via Sha'ar Hagai, Latrun Monastery of the Trappist Fathers (they produce their own olive oil, grape juice and wine available to purchase), proceed to Beit Shemesh, and visit Abraham's Well (subject for the road being safe to cross and open). Check-in to our hotel in Jerusalem. Dinner and overnight here.

Day 7, Sunday 10th May Jerusalem/ Tel Aviv

After breakfast we travel to Jaffa which is located in the oldest part of Tel Aviv. Jaffa is an ancient port city in Israel. It is most famous for its association with the biblical stories of Jonah, Solomon and Saint Peter as well as the mythological story of Andromeda and Perseus. Free time for the rest of your afternoon in Jaffa. Return to our hotel. Dinner and overnight here.



Day 8, Monday 11th May Jerusalem/Tiberias

We leave Jerusalem to travel to the north via Bethany to see St Lazarus Shrine. Proceed to Jericho via the Inn of the Good Samaritan to view the Mount of Temptation. We take a cable car up to the mountain and enjoy a scenic view overlooking the valley. Continue to Tiberias and check-in to our hotel. Dinner and overnight here.

Day 9, Tuesday 12th May Netanya/ Nahariya

After breakfast coach travel to the north to visit the historical crusader city of Acre via Caesarea, Megiddo, Bhai Gardens in Haifa. Return to our hotel in Tiberias. Evening dinner at the hotel.

Day 10, Wednesday 13th May Tiberias/Nahariya/Nazareth

We leave Tiberias and travel further north to Baniyas (Caesarea Philippi), via Meiron, Kiryat

Shmona, Dan Hurshat. Check-in to our hotel in Nazareth. Dinner and overnight here.

Day 11th Thursday 14th May Tiberias/Nazareth

We start our day with a boat ride on the Sea of Galilee followed by a visit to Magdala which is the home of Mary Magdalene. Proceed to St Peter's Primacy, Tabgha (the church of the multiplication of the loaves and fishes). We enjoy St Peter's Fish Lunch. Afterwards visit Capernaum, Mt. of Beatitudes and Bethsaida (the ancient city of the north). Return to our hotel and evening dinner here.

Day 12th Friday 15th May Nazareth/Cana

After breakfast, we travel to Mt Tabor (the church of Transfiguration), taxis to the summit and visit here. Proceed to the National Park of Tzipori (famous for its Byzantine mosaics). Continue to Cana, to see the Church of the wedding and on to Nazareth to visit the Basilica of the Annunciation. Return to hotel for dinner on your last night in the Holy Land.

Day 13th Saturday 16th May

Enjoy some free time in Nazareth before we travel back to Tel Aviv for your flight back to the London Luton.
