



Daily Itinerary

All tours are led by Catholic priests

Masses will be held in illustrious Shrines in the Holy Land and a local tour guide will accompany you throughout.




Day 1 UK/Tel Aviv/Bethlehem

Depart UK on our direct flight to Tel Aviv. Please wear your badge so that your leader can easily identify that you are one of the group. Upon arrival at Tel Aviv airport your guide and coach will be waiting to transfer you to your hotel in Bethlehem. Evening dinner at the hotel.

Day 2 Bethlehem / Shepherd's Field


After breakfast we walk to Manger Square, to the Basilica of the Nativity and immediately queue to view the birthplace of Jesus. Afterwards we celebrate Mass in St Joseph's Grotto followed by a tour of the basilica viewing the newly restored mosaic dating back to the 12/13th centuries, as well as St Catherine's church, St Jacob's cave and tomb. Proceed to Milk Grotto, just a short walk away and visit the Museum of the Miracles. We take lunch here. Afterwards we travel by coach to the Shepherds' Field, visiting the grottos there and the Chapel where the angels first sang 'Gloria in Excelsis Deo' on the night of the first Christmas. We may sing Christmas Carols here. We then drive to Jerusalem to visit the Holocaust Remembrance Centre. (This is not a guided visit.) Free time to explore the centre individually. We will briefly stop for some shopping in Bethlehem before returning to the hotel.



Day 3 Jerusalem (old city) & Mt Zion

Early departure to the Old City of Jerusalem. Proceed to the Pool of Bethesda and St Anne's Church (the birthplace of Our Lady). Continue on to visit the site of Pilate's Court, Churches of the Flagellation and the Crowning with Thorns followed by the Stations of the Cross along Via Dolorosa, following the route Our Lord walked on the first Good Friday and ending in the Holy Sepulchre Basilica - the holiest place on earth for all Christians. We celebrate Mass here and afterwards visit Mt Calvary, the Holy Tomb of Resurrection, St Mary Magdalene's Shrine, and the Grotto of the True Cross. Walk to Mt Zion and visit the Upper Room (last supper), King David's Tomb and the magnificent


Dormition Abbey where Our Lady was assumed to heaven. Then on to St Peter's in Gallicantu - a truly incredible Shrine - and visit the dungeon where Jesus was imprisoned after His mock trial on Maundy Thursday night. Return to our hotel for dinner.



Day 4

Jerusalem – Mt of Olives/Ein Karem/Holy Hour in Jerusalem

We first visit the Western Wall which is part of the remaining wall around the temple that was destroyed in AD70. This is the holiest place for Jews. Afterwards proceed to the summit of the Mt of Olives, Jerusalem; visit Ascension Dome, Pater Noster Grotto where Jesus taught His Prayer, Our Father. We then walk to Dominus Flevit (where Jesus wept over Jerusalem). We celebrate Mass here and afterwards proceed to Gethsemane Garden and Basilica to view the Rock of the Agony. We spend a few minutes here for prayer/reflection. Return to our hotel for our evening dinner. We will return to Jerusalem - Gethsemane for our Holy Hour of Eucharistic Adoration around the Rock of the Agony inside the Basilica of the Agony. This is the exact place Jesus underwent His Agony. Evening dinner at the hotel.



Day 5

Free day at leisure

We visit the Carmel of Bethlehem, a short walk (where King David lived as a boy). View here the magnificent chapel of St Joseph (designed by Christ and shown in a vision to the Founded by St. Mary of Jesus Crucified). We celebrate Mass here. Dinner at the hotel.

Day 6

Bethany/Jericho/Mt Tabor/Nazareth/Cana

We leave Bethlehem early and drive along the Jordan Valley to Bethany and visit St Lazarus's Church. Proceed to Jericho, view Mt of Temptation and Zacchaeus's Sycamore Tree and lunch here. Drive to the foot of Mt Tabor. We take taxis to the summit and we visit the Church of Transfiguration there. Proceed to Nazareth and on to the Annunciation Basilica (a magnificent Basilica that dominates the skyline of Nazareth). We visit

the Grotto




where the Annunciation took place and St Joseph's Grotto, where we celebrate Mass. Walking across the road we visit the Synagogue of Jesus and Mary's Well. Proceed to Cana for renewal of Marriage Vows. Check-in to our hotel in Nazareth. Evening dinner here.

Day 7

Tiberias/River Jordan/Tabga/Capernaum

After breakfast, drive to the River Jordan (Yardenit) for the renewal of Baptismal Vows, then on to Mt of Beatitudes where the Sermon on the Mount took place, St Peter's Primacy, where Christ appeared to the Apostles after His Resurrection, and the church of the Feeding of the 5,000. We will have lunch here and then sail on the Sea of Galilee to Capernaum - the town of Jesus - where we visit St Peter's Church. Here we view the

remains of the ancient Synagogue in which Jesus used to teach. We travel back to Bethlehem and check-in to our hotel. Dinner and overnight here.



Day 8

Ein Karem/Airport/UK

We say farewell to Bethlehem and travel to Ein Karem to visit St John the Baptist's birthplace followed by a visit of the Visitation Shrine of Our Lady to St Elizabeth, celebrating Mass here. Travel to the airport for our flight back to Manchester airport.
